



# The LOVE of Reading Book Swap

On Wednesday, March 12<sup>th</sup>, we will be hosting our 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Book Swap to promote the joy of reading at home. This is a great opportunity for parents to do a little spring cleaning, and for students to trade books “old” books for “new” books.

## HOW IT WORKS

Each family is encouraged to sort through their bookshelves at home to find books that are ready for new homes – books that have been outgrown, previously read, or no longer a favorite. Families are welcome to donate as many books as they like.

Families are encouraged to bring in *gently used* books between now, February 10<sup>th</sup>-March 11<sup>th</sup>. Books should be appropriate for K-5 readers and be in good condition.

Don't have books to donate? That's okay! **All** students will have an opportunity to choose a book. The goal is for every student to go home with at least one book.

## BOOK CRITERIA

Please make choices carefully before bringing in books. Books will only be accepted under the following guidelines...

- Books must be in a gently used condition – no rips, tears, stains, coloring, or writing on them
