Student Absences & Lates

SchoolMessenger App

Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the <u>Apple App Store</u> or the <u>Google Play Store</u>. The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.

SafeArrival Website

Using the SafeArrival website, go to: go.schoolmessenger.ca. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.

Administration of Medication to Students

If your child is required to take medication at school (i.e. asthma puffers, epi-pens, prescription medicines) a "Request for Administration of Medication at School" form must be completed by your family doctor and returned to our office. A form can be obtained at the school office. If there are any questions, please contact our school.



Nut Aware School

Due to students & staff who are severely allergic to nuts (both tree nuts and peanuts), Clearbrook Elementary is nut free in several classrooms. We ask that you do not send to school any food items that contain nuts for lunch or snacks. Review with your child the importance of hand-washing to ensure we keep our school safe for all.



Starfish Backpack Program

This program is organized by the Archway Food Bank with the coordination of many community partnerships. The purpose of the program is to support families in need with food over the weekend. Each student is provided a backpack with sufficient food (2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 2 dinners and some small treats).

Starfish Pack has been financially sustained by many Abbotsford businesses, church groups and community partners, including Abbotsford Rotary Club. These partnerships ensure the program is sustainable. The Archway Food Bank relies on their trusted partners to organize volunteers to do the shopping, fill the backpacks, and bring them to the school every Friday-or Thursday if Friday is a school holiday. Parent responsibility is to please send the 'Starfish' backpack back to school every Monday. Volunteers pick up backpacks on Tuesday-to be packed and ready on Thursday.

We are very appreciative of the work of everyone involved in the Starfish Pack Program. It is such a wonderful way to support our families who need some short-term assistance.



Please follow these step-by-step instructions, so you will begin to receive email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren).

Step 1: Register

- a) If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page https://abbotsford.schoolcashonline.com and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- b) Complete each of the three Registration Steps *For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

Note: Student Number is Not Required

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name
- b) Enter the School Name
- c) Enter Your Child's Name & Birth Date
- d) Select Continue
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select Continue
- f) Your child has been added to your account

Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" option and repeat the steps above. 5 children can be added to one parent account.

If you do not wish to add additional children, select "View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for

purchase will be displayed.


